Nature of support 2011/12

- Provision of one-to-one tuition
- Support for accessing school visits, residential trips, after-school clubs
- Small group interventions, lead by teaching assistant staff

Curriculum focus of PPG spending 2011/12

- One-to-one tuition for:
 - 1 pupil in reading
 - 1 pupil in writing
 - 1 pupil in maths
- Small group interventions in maths in Key Stage 2
- Individual reading intervention in Key Stage 1

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

- All eligible children were offered funding for residential visits to enable them to access the associated parts of the curriculum
- Some children took the opportunity to access after-school clubs supporting their confidence within the class setting
- Of the 15 children:
 - 93% are making good progress in reading
 - 87% are making good progress in writing
 - 93% are making good progress in maths
