

Personal Social Emotional Development (PSED)



We will be learning to:

- Listen to others when they talk.
- Be confident to share opinions and ideas.
- Understand how what we do affects other people.
- Work together as a group or whole class to achieve a goal.
- Talk about where in the world we have been.
- Follow the routines and expectations of the classroom.

Understanding the World (UW)

We are learning to:

- Find out about transport.
- Find out about the countries of the world.
- Talk about special times with the family (holidays).
- Find out about different ways we can travel around the world.
- Know that not all children have experienced the same things and are sensitive to this.
- To know the basics of how a car works.
- Create vehicle pictures on the computer.



Literacy



We will be learning to:

- Use phonic knowledge to read simple words and begin to read sentences.
- Use our phonic knowledge to spell some simple words.
- Spell some common irregular words e.g. the, to, was, she
- Explore rhyme in the story of 'Duck in a Truck'
- Write another verse for 'The Journey from Grandpa's'.
- Write labels, captions and simple sentences about journeys and vehicles.
- Use simple information texts to find out about vehicles



Reception Spring Term 1 Journeys/Transport

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

We will be learning to:

- Explore art and design from different countries.
- Combine different materials to make 3D models.
- Respond to and create music using instruments and voice.
- Represent our ideas about travel through art, role-play, music, dance and stories.



Mathematics

We will be learning to:

- Count accurately 10 objects and beyond.
- Order numbers to 10 and beyond.
- Find 1 more or less than a given number.
- Use a number sequence in practical contexts.
- Understand and use ordinal language.
- Describe events in their correct sequence.
- Use the mathematical language to describe shapes.



Communication and Language (C&L)

We will be learning to:

- Listen and respond to the stories of 'Duck in a Truck' and 'The Journey from Grandpa's'
- Listen and respond to information about making a journey.
- Give attention to someone else while engaged in an activity.
- Listen to and follow directions.
- Answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences of travelling/vehicles.
- Learn new and unfamiliar words in relation to the topic.



Physical Development (PD)

We will be learning to:

- Use a range of art tools safely.
- Move freely with control.
- Tackle a range of obstacles safely by going under, over and around.
- Talk about ways to keep us safe when we cross the road.
- Develop efficient pencil control to form recognisable letters (starting and ending in the right place).
- Use bikes and scooters outside with safety and control.
