<p><b>Literacy:</b> We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Blending sounds to read topic books</li> <li>• Making signs and labels for the classroom</li> <li>• Writing about the precious thing we would share just like the Rainbow Fish</li> <li>• Using simple information texts to find out about sea life</li> <li>• Writing our own version of the Pirate Pete story</li> <li>• Sending a message in a bottle</li> <li>• Exploring rhyme and writing our own poem</li> <li>• Creating a set of instructions to show how to find pirate treasure</li> </ul>	<p><b>Communication &amp; Language:</b> We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Looking at non-fiction books</li> <li>• Listening/responding to the stories of “Pirate Pete” and “The Rainbow Fish”</li> <li>• Learning new and unfamiliar words in relation to the topic.</li> <li>• Compiling a box of books, both fiction and non-fiction to support our topic.</li> <li>• Learning new songs about things that live in the sea</li> <li>• Tell our own Stories around the theme of the sea</li> <li>• Giving attention to someone else whilst engaged in our own activity.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Maths:</b> We will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Digging for treasure and adding the amounts together to find the total</li> <li>• Sorting sea creatures into groups</li> <li>• Revisiting how far to sail to Africa/Spain/France/etc ?</li> <li>• Answering number problems using adding and subtracting</li> <li>• Writing number sentences as a way of recording the answer to problems</li> <li>• Making a map to find the pirate treasure and reading map coordinates using compass points</li> <li>• Making our own Tessellations like fish scales</li> </ul>
