Characteristics of Effective Learning

This is one part of the Curriculum which supports all the others. Through the year we will focus on supporting your child to embed and develop their **Characteristics of Effective Learning**. These are the ways in which children engage with their learning.

- 1. **Playing and exploring** Children investigate and experience things and 'have a go'.
- 2. **Active learning** Children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties, and enjoy achievements.
- Creating and thinking critically Children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things.

Communication and Language Listening Attention and Understanding

Maintain attention in whole class/groups.
Follow 1 step instructions.
Understand simple questions.
Understand and follow instructions.
Listen carefully to stories and other childrens' descriptions of their summers.

Speaking

Use Short sentences. Use talk to organize play. Talk about themselves. Talk about what they have been doing over the summer using the past tense. Talk about what other children did in the summer. Make links to their own experiences. Learn different ways to start talking to their peers

Learn and use new vocabulary connected to feelings-(Colour Monster and other books)

Show and Tell: Share your Holiday bag with the class and respond to Show and Tell with your own thoughts and ideas

Personal Social and Emotional Development Self Regulation

Begin to recognise and express their feelings. Understand, name and describe different feelings.

Managing Self

Understand that rules need to be followed and the importance of looking after our resources. Begin to build understanding of perseverance.

Building Relationships

Build positive relationships with and play alongside and with others.

Physical Development-(including P.E.)

Gross Motor Skills

P.E. Fundamentals Unit- balance, run, jump, hop, change direction

Investigate and manipulate balancing, climbing and movement possibilities in our outside area.

Fine Motor Skills

Access to lots of hand strengthening activities including playdoh, plasticene and clay.

Understand how to hold and use a range of tools including scissors, paintbrushes, tweezers, pens and pencils.

Understand that Print has meaning. Know how to take care of books(turning page carefully, holding the right way up) . Begin to engage in conversations about stories

Word Reading

Recognise graphemes and know their corresponding phoneme. Begin to orally blend CVC words.

Begin to recognise Harder to Read and Spell words (HRSW)

Writing

Adult scribing. Promote tripod grip Give meanings to marks made and label characters and images with initial sounds. Begin to form letters correctly. Begin to orally segment a word in order to write it.

ELS- Phase 2 phonics

Explore storytelling elements in the music and create a class story inspired by the piece. · Identify and describe contrasts in tempo and dynamics. · Begin to use musical terms (louder/quieter, faster/slower, higher/lower). · Respond to music in a range of ways e.g. movement, talking, writing
