**Curious:** inquisitive and inquiring

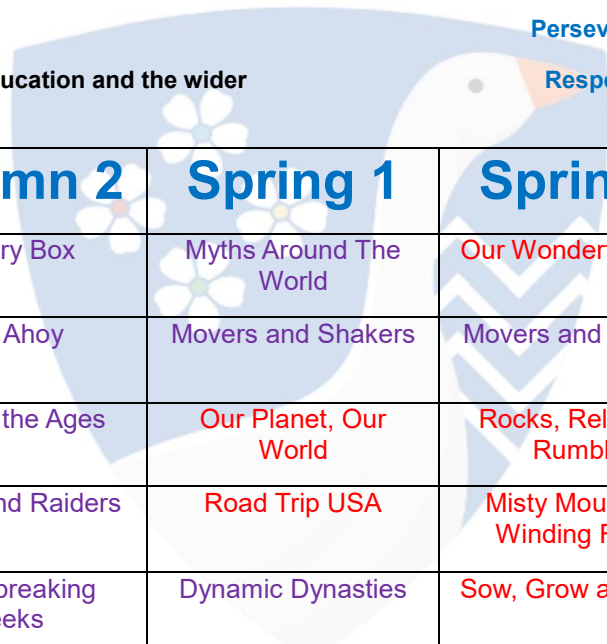
**Empathetic:** welcoming of others' opinions and valuing the feelings of others
